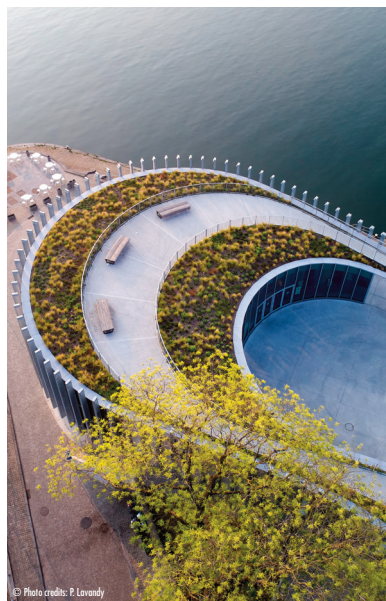

The exhibition: "Hatching the city of tomorrow"

The NID, an acronym for Namur Intelligent and Sustainable, puts citizens at the heart of the debate on the future of Namur and questions the role of cities in the face of current and future challenges.

Our society is facing many dangers: climate change, energy dependency, erosion of biodiversity, conflicts, loss of social links, impoverishment... If cities are - at least in part - at the origin of these problems, they can also be the source of solutions!

To reflect together on these challenges, the NID has developed an exhibition.

This exhibition is divided into 3 areas:

- **Namur in question**

A film briefly explains the history of the universe, placing man chronologically within it. The film then shows the role that cities can play in solving global problems.

- **Namur in transition**

Through different tools (videomapping, mechanical/multimedia interactives, mixed reality headset), discover in a didactic and playful way different themes closely linked to urban development.

- **Namur tomorrow**

This space is dedicated to debate and co-construction. In addition to a conference area, there is a 3D map of Namur and virtual reality headsets.

"The Grognon in past times"

This immersive experience takes you back in time to discover what the Grognon looked like in Neolithic period, in Gallo-Roman period and in the Middle Ages.

The interactive city tour: "eNIDgma"

Do you like playing?

Do you like learning in an original way?

Do you like discovering new things?

The NID's interactive urban game is for you!



Through a playful and interactive route and with the help of an application on a tablet lent for the occasion, walk through the historical centre of Namur, discover the different themes that make the sustainability of a city and solve different riddles. Collaboration, reflection and creativity are on the agenda!

This cooperation game has been adapted to two target audiences. One version is dedicated to families. Another one is for high school students.
